The help of volunteers and the low administrative costs allow for 98% of all donations to reach persons in need and who do not receive social benefit payments in Japan as German citizens. In light of the catastrophic events in Japan, the Ambassador Dittmann Fund's President, Dr. Karl Roser, and its Board Members decided to assist affected Japanese citizens with additional financial support. We would like to support this good cause from Germany as well and would be delighted if you could attend the exhibition, enjoy Shoichi Sakurai's artwork in a relaxed atmosphere and support our Japanese friends in need by joining us for plenty of drink and food.
